Learning Topics

Last term as part of our winter theme we enjoyed exploring ice, making snow dough and making bird feeders. We celebrated Chinese New Year and enjoyed tasting noodles and rice.

This term our theme will be spring, which will include looking at colours, growing and Easter. We will do lots of activities to cover these subjects including art activities, cooking, outside play and exploration etc.

We have a weekly show and tell day - this means that during the term there will be several opportunities for your child to take part- sharing an item of their choice from home. This term we will be concentrating on 'colours' and will look at a different one each week. We also have fantastic sheets that can be written any day and are a lovely way to share a recent achievement- getting dressed, sleeping in own bed, toilet training, swimming, a trip to the dentist/doctor etc.
